



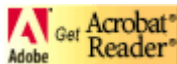

Hampton-Pinckney set for latest condos project

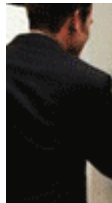
After serving as a sanctuary for various congregations for 85 years, a historic neighborhood church will soon be the sanctuary of families as the quaint brick building begins a transformation to upscale condominiums.

Schafer Gioia Partners, LLC, consisting of Susan Schafer Gioia and husband Nello Gioia, have teamed with Ard Wood Holcombe and Slate Architects, and GA Ziegler Construction Company to transform a church, which was originally built in 1919, into a multi-unit residence. Located in the Hampton-Pinckney Historic District, the church is at the intersection of Hampton Avenue and Hudson Street. The condos will be known as The Hamptons.

"We have faith," says Schafer. "We're very vested in downtown Greenville and now we have invested in downtown."

She says passing by the church regularly, the beauty of the architecture in combination with its setting among the historic homes seemed to call out to her, and when a "For Sale" sign went up she followed the calling.
